

**Public Hearing
Pentwater Township**

The Pentwater Township Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, March 21, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in the Pentwater Community Hall, located at 327 South Hancock St., Pentwater, Michigan.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comments on proposed amendments to the Pentwater Community Zoning Ordinance that will affect Pentwater Township properties only. The proposed Pentwater Community Zoning Ordinance amendments would regulate camping and vehicle storage, particularly on private, non-commercial vacant property within the Township. New definitions for “camping” and “camping unit” are proposed. A new Section 3.36 would regulate camping as an accessory use and would clarify that camping is not permitted on vacant lands (non-campground lands). Revisions to existing regulations of outdoor recreational vehicle and equipment storage would also be considered, to make the outdoor storage regulations compatible with the new camping regulations.

All interested persons may attend the hearing and comment on the proposed amendments. A copy of the proposed Pentwater Community Zoning Ordinance amendments is on file in the Township office, 327 South Hancock St., Pentwater, Michigan 49449, and may be reviewed during Township office hours. Written comments concerning the proposed amendments may be submitted to the Township, to the attention of the zoning administrator, at the above-stated address, up to the time of and during the public hearing.
