

**PENTWATER TOWNSHIP TRANSFER STATION

(adopted March 29, 2017)**

Located on Monroe Road and is accessed by driving south on the gravel road between the old River House Trading Post and Dollar General Store. The site is approximately one-half mile south of Monroe Road. The Transfer Station attendant is onsite during hours of operation.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED

Residents may deposit recyclable materials including paper, cardboard, plastic, metal and glass at no charge. There is a fee for all other garbage, trash and debris.

Residents may also deposit the same recyclable materials at no charge from November 1st through March 31st at Summit Township Transfer Station on Lakeshore Drive. The Summit Township Transfer Station is open on Wednesdays and Sundays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Township residents must first obtain a permit to utilize the Summit Township Transfer Station. Permits are issued at the Pentwater Township offices during normal business hours.

Pentwater Township also conducts two "free" days per year as an added service to its residents and property owners. Contractors may not dispose of materials during the free days. **The free days the first Saturday in June and the first Saturday in October.**

Hazardous waste is not accepted; however, residents may drop off hazardous materials, including pharmaceuticals and electronics at the **Annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day at Hart DPW building on the 3rd Saturday of August from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

Residents may also dispose of brush, leaves and yard waste at the site for no charge. The yard waste site is open at all times. Commercial yard waste haulers must obtain a permit from the Township before disposing of such materials.
