<p>Supervisor Spitler called the Special Meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. for the purpose of interviewing two people for the position of Transfer Station Operator.  Members Present: Spitler, Johnson, Holub, Siska and Flynn  Members Absent: None</p>	<p><b>CALL TO ORDER</b></p> <p><b>ROLL CALL</b></p>
<p>No public present.</p>	<p><b>PUBLIC COMMENTS ON AGENDA ITEMS</b></p>
<p>Two persons applied for the position of Transfer Station Attendant by the deadline of February 3, 2020.</p> <p><b>Ms. Christine Malburg</b> was interviewed first at 10:00 a.m. She explained her past work history and ties to the community. She also volunteers at the Transfer Station during the Free Days.</p> <p>It was related that the Hours of Operation would be reduced from 3 days per week to 2 days per week. She suggested a different work schedule to include the same number of hours in a week but only a half day on Saturday.</p> <p><b>Mr. Ramone Martinez's</b> interview began at 10:35 a.m. He had worked with the Cemetery Sexton. He most recently worked with the Transfer Station Operator as a paid attendant. He also did the mowing for the Township near Longbridge. He can operate various equipment (front-end loader, tractor, backhoe) and was trained in welding. He currently is a self-employed contractor.</p> <p>When asked about the Transfer Station hours, Mr. Martinez responded that full days are better than half days for customers.</p>	<p><b>INTERVIEWS</b></p>
<p>Mr. Spitler indicated that two other people (both previous Transfer Station Operators) have expressed interest in the position. Mr. Holub asked about the process of considering others who did not apply during the published timeframe. It was determined that the timeframe would be extended.</p>	

<p>Ms. Johnson recommended that the Supervisor be authorized to make the final determination as to who his hired as the Transfer Station Operator reports to the Supervisor. The other members agreed.</p>
